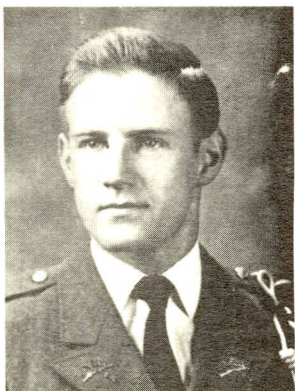


1999 OUTSTANDING ALUMNUS
